Jim's guided tour includes the Hometown Heritage Museum featuring memorabilia and personal items of Lewis Grizzard, the famous Southern humorist, columnist and author and a 19th-century farmhouse which features art, memorabilia and press about the famous, cutting-edge 20th-century novelist Erskine Caldwell (Tobacco Road and God's Little Acre). We'll have lunch at the historic Sprayberry's BBQ (1pm, not included with your fee), founded in 1926 and featuring The Lewis Grizzard Special (a barbecue sandwich, Brunswick stew, and onion rings). Next, Jim will take us on an afternoon drive around Newnan, GA, which in the mid 1800's was one of the wealthiest cities in the country. With its six historic districts, all on the national register, Newnan boasts some of Georgia's most beautiful homes and commercial buildings.
